## Water Main, Storm Drain, and Electrical Duct Bank Installation

### JACKSON CONSTRUCTION DETAIL

#### Weekday Work:

- Electrical duct bank installation between 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>
- Water main installation between 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>
- Water main installation between 8<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>

#### Weekend Work:

- Electrical duct bank and vault installation between 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>
- Water main installation between 6<sup>th</sup> and Maynard
- Storm drain installation at 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue intersection

#### Work Hours:

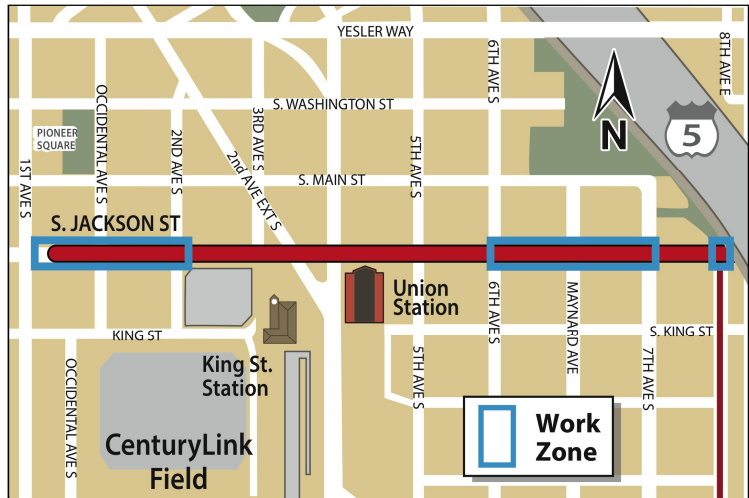
- Weekdays 7:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.
- Weekend 7:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.

#### What to Expect During This Week's Construction:

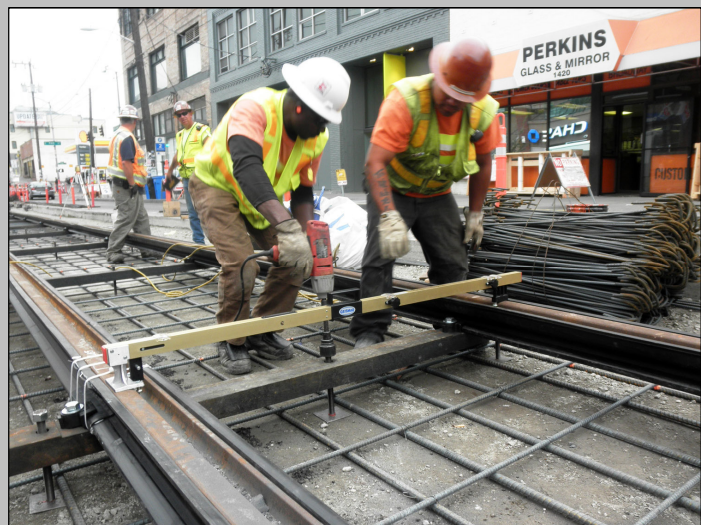
- On-street parking and loading restrictions
- Temporarily blocked alleys on Jackson in Pioneer Square
- One travel lane in each direction
- Pedestrian detours
- Construction noise, dust and increased truck activity

#### Note on Water Main Shutoffs:

October 6<sup>th</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup> will begin the first of three weekend water shutoffs in October for the Chinatown/International District. The shutoffs will begin at 10:00 p.m. on Saturdays and continue until 10:00 a.m. on Sundays. If your building will be affected you will receive a notice directly from Seattle Public Utilities at least 72 hours in advance.
