Water Main, Storm Drain, and Electrical Duct Bank Installation

JACKSON CONSTRUCTION DETAIL

Weekday Work:

- Electrical duct bank installation between 1st and 2nd
- Water main installation between 6th and 7th
- Water main installation between 8th and 10th

Weekend Work:

- Electrical duct bank and vault installation between 1st and 2nd
- Water main installation between 5th and 6th
- Storm drain installation at 8th Avenue intersection

Work Hours:

- Weekdays 7:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.
- Weekend 7:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.

What to Expect During This Week's Construction:

- On-street parking and loading restrictions
- Temporarily blocked alleys on Jackson in Pioneer Square
- One travel lane in each direction
- Pedestrian detours
- Construction noise, dust and increased truck activity

Note on Water Main Shutoffs:

October 6th – 7th will begin the first of three weekend water shutoffs in October for the Chinatown/International District. The shutoffs will begin at 10:00 p.m. on Saturdays and continue until 10:00 a.m. on Sundays. If your building will be affected you will receive a notice directly from Seattle Public Utilities at least 72 hours in advance.
