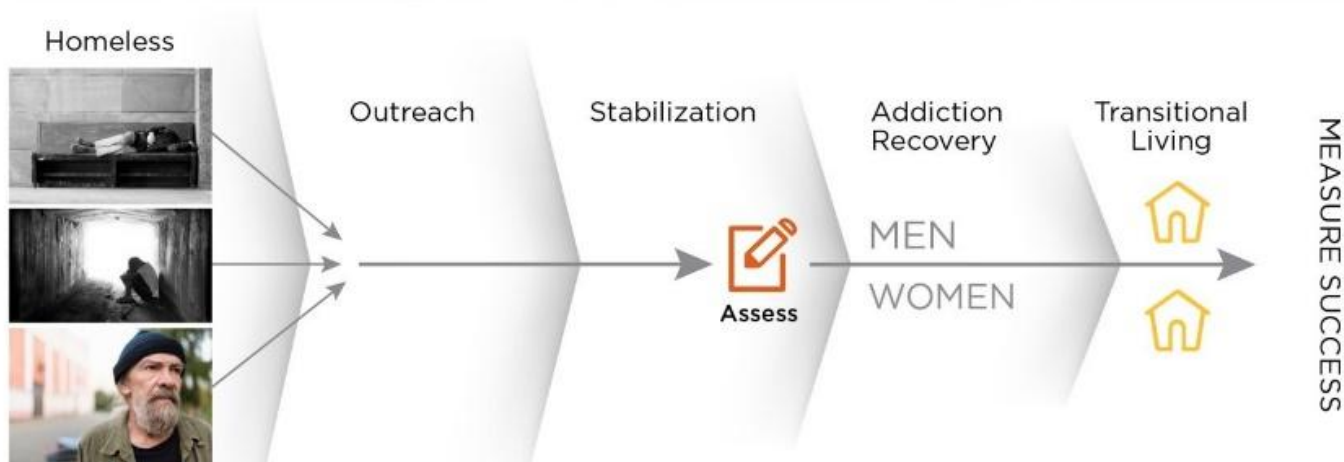

2020/2021 CITY BUDGET

- 2020 Budget Rebalancing: In September, City Council voted 7-2 to override a veto by Mayor Durkan of the Council's 2020 Rebalance Package. Some implications for the rest of 2020 include: cutting 32 SPD officers from patrol, disbanding the Navigation Team, and including more funding for community-led public safety.
- In late September, [Mayor Durkan released her 2021 proposed budget](#). The Mayor's priorities in building the 2021 budget included:
 - Continuing the city's response to the COVID-19 pandemic
 - Targeted \$100m investment in BIPOC communities
 - Delaying capital projects
 - Hiring and wage freezes to stabilize staffing costs
 - Shifting SPD roles and responsibilities such as 911 into civilian-led department
- Next steps: Council is in process of 2021 budget deliberations. Council Members are holding virtual town halls to solicit feedback as well as continuing public comment in budget meetings.



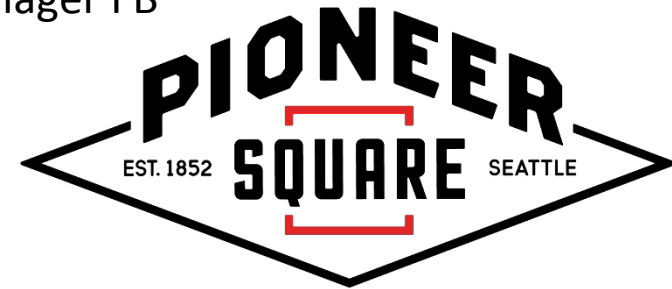
ALLEY LIGHTING MATCHING FUND

- With \$50,000 in funding from Historic South Downtown, we aim to support alley lighting improvements in Pioneer Square.
- Property owners and building tenants who obtain written permission from their property owner are welcome to apply.
- Applicants seeking funding may request funds for 50% of project costs (maximum award is \$8,000).

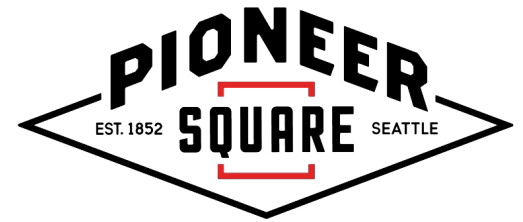
